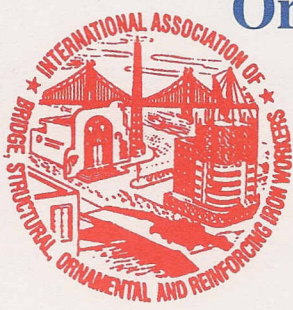

## **IRONWORKERS**

### **Basic Qualifications for the Apprenticeship Program**

At least 18 years of age

Education: High School diploma or GED

Physically fit to perform work of the trade

Valid Drivers license

Veterans must submit a copy of their DD214 Form

Familiar with construction is helpful

Needs to furnish own hand tools

Much of the work is performed outdoors. Often will be walking beams above ground level

Apprentice will receive incremental wage increases beginning at 55% of journeyman scale
