* First period Apprentices receive no fringe benefits. Please note that although 1st Period Apprentices receive no fringe benefits, you must still withhold and remit the 7% working assessments for them.

NOTE: There is a working assessment of seven percent (7%) which is deducted from the total gross wages earned by each Ironworker employed in Local 48's jurisdiction and remitted to Local 48. Fringe Benefits shall be paid on All Hours Worked
