Nominations And Elections

A special meeting will be held for nominations of officers and nominations and election of Judge's of Election on Friday, May 15, 2009 from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Union Hall. This is a special meeting no other business will be transacted. An April 2009 or later dues receipt is required and must be presented to gain admittance to the meeting. The office will be open for those members wishing to purchase dues. The regular monthly meeting will take place after nominations at 8:00 p.m.

Eligibility Requirements For Candidates For Local Union Office

To be a Candidate for Office in any Iron Workers Local Union, a member must be:

1. A Journeyman Member of such Local union for at least two (2) continuous years.
2. In continuous good standing for the twenty-four (24) months preceding the date of nominations, as well as the date of election.
3. A practical worker in some branch of the trade, having worked as such for six (6) months or more in the past year unless said member has been injured or incapacitated at the trade and still retains active membership in the Local Union.

Election of Officers

A special meeting will be held on Friday, June 12, 2009 for the election of officers of Iron Workers Local Union No. 549. Voting will take place from 2:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Union Hall. A May or later dues receipt is required and must be presented to vote. The office will be open for those wishing to purchase dues. Apprentices and/or Honorary Members are not permitted to vote.
